

## The Tradition *Continues...*




They placed 15<sup>th</sup> out of 39 teams and had top ten finishes in two of the events.

# Math Team

Once again, the AC Math Team had a very successful year, finishing in the top 11 out of the 45 teams in the Massachusetts Mathematics League. Alvernia, Woburn, and Minuteman, typically finishing in the top two or three in each meet. Our top scorer was Ryan Guo, who had a near perfect score in each competition, a rare feat. Ryan won a scholarship as one of the top point scorers in the League.
